Present Continuous

Present Continuous Affirmative

we use "be" + "ing" verbs

I am walking.

She is talking.

He is laughing.

It is raining.

They are singing.

We are cooking.

You are smiling.

El presente continuo es un tiempo verbal que se usa para hablar de las cosas que suceden en el momento, se caracteriza estructuralmente por agregarle la terminación -ing a los verbos. Para usar esta estructura debemos conocer el verbo to be, el cual se usa para hablar sobre quien o que soy y donde estoy o estoy haciendo (ser o estar)

Verb to be: am – is – are

La forma que debo utilizar depende del sujeto de la oración

Pronombres: I-You-He-She-It- We- They

I am – You are – He is – She is – It is – We are – They are
