## BE GOING TO + INFINITIVE

The future **going to** is used:

- + **To make predictions about the near future.**

Ex: Oh, look! It's going to rain.

- + **To talk about intentions and definite future plans.**

Ex: I'm going to see my grandma tomorrow.

I'm going to spend my holidays in the States, that's for sure.


We **aren't going to** buy a new car.
