SINCE AND FOR FOR vs. SINCE



English Stud

I have been living in Spain *for* 6 years. (duration of time)
I have been living in Spain *since* 2012. (starting point)



Using FOR and SINCE in Present Perfect

We use FOR to talk about a length of time, a period of time. We use **SINCE** to talk about a point in the past, a specific point in time.

Example Sentences FOR

- · I have worked here for 8 years.
- You have played football for ten years.
- We have taught at this school for a long time.
- He has been a student for eight years.
- · They've been married for 30 years.
- She has been in prison for 6 months.
- I haven't been on holiday for ages.

Example Sentences SINCE

- He has lived here since 1993.
- They have been at the hotel since last week.
- I haven't ridden a horse since I was 9.
- You have worked here since you left your school.
- I haven't been on holiday since last year.
- Since his wife went away, he has been waiting for her.
